Bay 3 has UHF/DMR capabilities. Bay 4 has a P25 capable radio. The plan for these stations is to include the use of the AMP that is mounted on the bench. A new Yaesu FT 710 has been purchased and will be installed in Bay1 of the radio console. 12 members donated funds to pay for the Yaesu FT 710 purchase.. Thanks to all who donated.
