Otis was a member of the Bouvet Island DXpedition team that went to Bouvet Island Jan/Feb 2023. Bouvet Island is the most isolated place on planet Earth. The island is located about 1,500 miles SW of the Cape of Good Hope and about 1,000 miles north of the mainland of Antarctica. Bouvet is of volcanic origin, extremely rocky and mostly icecovered. It is undoubtably one of the most dangerous DX entities to activate. Dr. Vicens has also gone on other DXpeditons to include Svalbard which is a Norwegian archipelago between Norway and the North Pole and Easter Island. His next adventure is a DXpedition to the Juan Fernandez Islands located off the coast of Chile in February 2024.
